Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 3 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the resolution.

PRESIDENT: LR 335 is adopted. Proceed now to General File. Matters for the record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, a few items. The Agriculture and Environment Committee will meet in Executive Session today at ten o'clock underneath the north balcony.

Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports they have carefully examined and reviewed LB 811 and recommend that same be placed on Select File with E & R amendments attached. (See pages 756-60 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, I have hearing notice from the Appropriations Committee. That is offered by Senator Warner as Chair.

Mr. President, your Committee on Agriculture and Environment, whose Chair is Senator Rod Johnson, reports LB 312 to General File with committee amendments attached. That is signed by Senator Rod Johnson. (See page 761 of the Journal.)
