SENATOR LAMB: Are we all here?

SPEAKER NICHOL: Did you want call ins?

SENATOR LAMB: Could the Clerk read the amendment so that the people know what it is about?

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay.

SENATOR LAMB: And then we'll have a roll call, please.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Lamb's amendment would read, on page 3 reinstate lines 19, 20, and 21. On line 20 and 21 strike "5,000" and insert "3,500." Reinstated lines 24, 25, and 26, on page 3. On line 26 strike "5,000" and insert "3,500." Strike all of Section 2. (Took roll call vote as found on page 791 of the Legislative Journal.) 23 ayes, 22 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The motion fails. Anything else on it, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Lamb would move to amend. (Lamb amendment appears on page 791 of the Journal.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Call is raised. Senator Lamb, please

SENATOR LAMB: 3,000, 3,000, okay.

(Laughter.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Going, going, he's gone. Any other discussion? Senator Pappas.

SENATOR PAPPAS: Are we on the amendment or the advancement of the bill? This is on his amendment?
