CLERK: 18 ayes, 1 nay to go under call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The house is under call. Please record your presence. Those not in the Chamber, please return and record your presence. I don't see any unauthorized personnel on the floor. Yes, I do now. Call in votes are authorized. We are voting on the Lamb amendment. Yes, he said take call ins.

CLERK: Senator DeCamp voting yes. Senator Wesely changing from yes to no. Senator Rogers voting yes. Senator Schmit voting yes. Senator Hannibal voting no.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Have you all voted? Lowell Johnson, Senator Lowell Johnson, will you record your presence. We are looking for Senator Morehead. Thank you. Call in votes have been authorized. We are voting on the Lamb amendment. Record, Mr. Clerk, please. Senator Lamb.

SENATOR LAMB: Roll call.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay. Roll call vote has been asked for. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll all vote taken. See page 792 of the Legislative Journal.) 24 ayes, 23 nays, Mr. President.
