

SENATOR PAPPAS: Very briefly, Mr. Speaker, colleagues, I'll point out a couple of things that were said. You did get the article that I talked about. It is on your desk. It pointed out that the problems there are in the country now, this will make more licensed and experienced electricians available for farm work than is presently in place. Also Senator Lamb talked about if he knew what the bill was going to be like or anything he'd have stopped it on consent calendar. I will point out that a year ago Senator Lamb did stop it on consent calendar. He wanted to basically talk the bill to death. I asked Senator Lamb if he, instead of would talk it to death, if he would just put a kill motion on it and I would pass over it so it would give another senator within this body the courtesy to try to pass their bill on instead of wasting 15 minutes on my bill. I did that. I gave the consent to pass over it a year ago. He had a chance to stop it on consent again this year, he did the previous year. I think this is a bill that is long overdue, it has been long needed. It's been afforded all the potential debate. You saw on the committee statement just one person opposed it, that was the League of Municipalities. There were seven or eight people who testified for the bill. I ask for the advancement of the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? We are voting on the advancement of the bill. Record vote has been asked for. Have you all voted? A record vote has been asked for, and it is on the advancement of the bill. The board is still open. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on pages 792-93 of the Journal.) 27 ayes, 16 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill advances. We have two ladies wishing recognition. Senator Marsh, for what purpose do you rise.
