PRESIDENT: The Chair was just going to invite debate on the saddle horse amendment. Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: When it comes to wasting time, I just thought we ought to bring in the jackass because that is what we are making of all of ourselves and I think it is about time to cut the nonsense out. I guess that is probably a priority thing with Senator Hefner but I really think that from the standpoint of time we have reached another pinnacle, I guess. I give up.

And so, therefore, with that in mind, I move for the adoption of LR 343.

PRESIDENT: The motion is the adoption of the resolution 343. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. We are voting on the adoption of resolution 343 offered by Senator Hefner. Please record your vote. May we have some assistance on the resolution, please. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the resolution.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries, the resolution is adopted. Matters for the record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports they have carefully examined and reviewed LB 772 and recommend that same be placed on Select File.
