

SENATOR HARRIS: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, this is a relatively simple amendment and it is suggested by the PERB Board where it allows a change in the retirement age for the judges. And the amendment says after death we would insert, "or at the age of 65, whichever is greater". It is a relatively simple amendment. Again, this is not a cost amendment. This is a system financed proposal, no cost to the state. Thank you.

CLERK: Mr. President, 298, I have E & R amendments, Senator.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I would move the E & R amendments be adopted.
