

planning authorities, and other such entities, that should know that there is going to be a newly developed piece of territory out in their area so they can plan their services. As an amendment we decided that the city should also be notified. That prompted the bill drafter, when they were reading the bill, to state that if we are going to notify the cities, we need to clarify a couple of things. First, we need to clarify that it is the planning department of a city that is notified, number one. And, number two, that we should say when an SID in whole or in part is located in a city's zoning jurisdiction that the city planning department should be notified. This amendment, basically, clarifies those two notification points. It is one of those amendments that is slightly beyond the power of E & R to enact but not one that significantly changes the bill. I urge your adoption of the amendment.
