

which will follow. I would hate to see us leave and not do something. I do repeat that I know in my district, according to my questionnaire, 43 percent of the people felt some sort of an adjustment was appropriate and I can see us getting down to the end after rationalizing this all out and not have done anything. And I don't think that is right either. So please consider your votes very carefully if, in fact, you are in favor of doing something, because if you don't consider those votes carefully, conceivably you will get down to the end and you will not have done something. Now, if you don't want to do anything, then I am sure that is just fine with you. Senator Warner's amendment proposes in the final analysis to take the Governor to 74,000, approximately. My preferred amendment would take the Governor to 58,500. Senator Warner's amendment, as proposed right now, would take the Governor or would take the Attorney General to sixty-one, approximately, sixty-one one; my proposed preferred amendment would take the Attorney General to fifty-seven eight, almost fifty-eight. On the other officers, the constitutional officers would all go, in Senator Warner's amendment proposed, would be 51,000; my preferred amendment would take them to thirty-eight eight, which is almost thirty-nine. Senator Warner's amendment, as proposed would take the Public Service Commissioners to about 40,000 and mine would take it to thirty-two eight, which is almost thirty-three. So in your own minds, I guess I am at the point where I would ask you to either decide to support Senator Warner's amendment, if you think those are appropriate adjustments, or to wait and support mine if you think those are more appropriate. But I wanted to lay it out in detail for you if you haven't been following. Remember, the final analysis in Senator Warner's amendment would take the Governor to 74,000; my proposed would take it to fifty-eight five. The Attorney General, Senator Warner's would be 61,000, approximately, and mine would be approximately 58,000. There is not a big difference in spread here, not a great deal of difference in the Attorney General's but there is some. There is almost 10,000 in the Governor's salary, not as much in the Attorney General's. So please consider your votes on especially these two amendments. Thank you.
