PRESIDENT: The question now is, shall the house come under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 9 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries and the house is under call. Members sitting in your seats, please look up to the front of the Legislature and put on your presence light. Record your presence. See that your green light is on. Members outside the Legislative Chamber, please return to the Senate Chamber, your presence is requested for the purpose of a call of the house and a roll call vote on the Warner-Landis amendment.
