

PRESIDENT: Do you have anything to say for Martha?

SENATOR DECAMP: Oh, I don't think the Energy Office will be there that long that it matters.

PRESIDENT: Is there discussion on the Banking Committee's confirmation report offering...confirming the appointment of Martha Beaman to the Energy Commission? If not, the motion is to adopt the confirmation report of the Banking Committee. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the report.

PRESIDENT: The confirmation report is adopted and Mrs. Beaman is confirmed. Now we proceed into Final Reading. All members are to be in your seats. (Gavel.) Members, we are going into Final Reading which requires, under the rules, all members to be in your seats. We will proceed with Final Reading when all members are in your seats. If the Sergeant-at-Arms would, very diplomatically, request members to take their seats, we will proceed with Final Reading. Members, please take your seats and we will proceed with Final Reading. The estimated time for Final Reading this morning is about half an hour. So it will expedite matters if you do stay in your seats in accordance with the rules. If we may have quiet in the Chamber, please. (Gavel.) We are going to pass over LB 578 this morning at the Speaker's suggestion, and proceed, Mr. Clerk, with LB 663.

CLERK: (Read LB 663 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 663 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. We are voting on LB 663, Final Reading. Please record your vote. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 858-59 of the Legislative Journal.) 36 ayes, 6 nays, 7 excused and not voting, Mr. President.
