

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Yes. Mr. Speaker, members of the body, I am going to take 30 seconds. LB 524 is a priority bill. It was designated as a priority bill by Senator Hoagland last year. It continues with its priority bill status. If revived...if res...if pulled from the committee, ultimately it will be heard on this floor in due course. This vote, right this moment, is simply a vote to allow, to allow another vote as to whether or not this bill should be removed from committee. That is all it is. But it does take 30 votes. I would ask you in fairness, even though you may oppose this particular measure, to at least allow the original vote that was taken last week to be recast. That is all this first motion does.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to suspend the rules and place 524 on General File. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Thirty votes required. Motion is to suspend the rules and place 524 on General File. Thirty votes are required. Please record your vote. Chair will allow 15 seconds for recording of votes. Please record your vote, aye or nay. Motion to suspend the rules and place 524 on General File. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk. Call of the house has been requested. Question is, shall the house come under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 15 ayes, 3 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion carried, the house is under call. All members of the house, please put on your presence light up in the front. Senator Goodrich, please record your presence. Senator Nichol, please record your presence. Senator Warner and Senator Harris, we have a red light for you, but we need a green one. Thank you. Senator Nichol, please return to the Chamber, the house is under call. Senator Nichol is the only one we are waiting for. How do you wish to proceed, Senator Johnson? All members are here. We will proceed now with a roll call vote. May we please have order (gavel) in the Chamber so the Clerk may hear your oral vote. The motion is to suspend the rules to place 524 on General File. Thirty votes required. Clerk will call the roll.
