contract with DEC to carry out those regulations, much the same as the Fire Marshall's office does with local fire departments.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the committee amendments, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The committee amendments are adopted. Senator Chizek.

SENATOR CHIZEK: Mr. Speaker, as Chairman Johnson identified, the amendment to the bill now simply would...the bill would delete 81-1528 and allow the department to contract with the municipalities. It would be a lot easier to handle when people are coming in and getting their permits, et cetera, and I would ask for advancement of the bill.

PRESIDENT: Is there discussion on LB 491? If not, the motion is to advance the bill from General File. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.
