the adoption of the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: Is there discussion on the committee amendments? If not, the motion is to adopt the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. We are voting on the committee amendments to LB 603. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: The amendments are adopted. Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President and members, LB 603 should be advanced to Select File to provide a vehicle to adopt the federal conformative standards for certification of our Uniform Commercial Code Central Indexing System. The recently enacted federal farm bill provides that the Department of Agriculture shall issue regulations for the states to follow in compliance with maintaining central filing or central indexing systems. The regulations are expected to be published in mid-March of this year and the conformity amendments must be due by December 15th. In that case, the USDA certifies the central filing system or the indexing system. 603 would serve as a vehicle for those amendments if that happens and so I would move the bill be advanced as amended.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance LB 603 from General File. Is there further discussion? All those in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

PRESIDENT: LB 603 is advanced. We are omitting LB 623 this morning, passing over 623 and on to LB 174.

CLERK: Mr. President, 174 was a bill that was introduced by Senator DeCamp. (Read title.) The bill was read on January 15 of last year, referred to Revenue, advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending, Mr. President.
