

February 21, 1986 LB 174, 561

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, there are committee amendments to this measure. The committee amendments, frankly, eliminated some obsolete material in the appeal statutes.

PRESIDENT: Is there discussion on the committee amendments? The motion is to adopt the amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Please record your vote on the adoption of the committee amendments. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the committee amendments, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The committee amendments are adopted. Senator Johnson.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Senator DeCamp brought this bill in to make some small procedural changes in the way an individual took an appeal from the County Board of Equalization and Assessment into the District Court. The Revenue Committee heard those small requests for procedural changes, agreed with them, so, too, did virtually everybody else who testified and that is all the bill does. I move its advancement.

PRESIDENT: Is there discussion on the bill, LB 174? All those in favor of advancing the bill vote aye, opposed vote nay. We are moving to advance LB 174. Have you all voted? Please record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 174 is advanced. Next is LB 561.

CLERK: 561, Mr. President, is by Senator Hannibal. (Read title.) It was read on January 22, referred to Revenue, advanced to General File. There are Revenue Committee amendments. Senator Johnson.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, this is a major tax expenditure bill. Senator Hannibal, for a long time, has carried water for the oxygen equipment people. He has carried air for them as well.
