And that, of course, has to also be brought to the attention of the board of directors of the insurance company. It was brought to me by Bankers Life of Nebraska and I would move for the advancement of the bill.

PRESIDENT: Is there discussion on the bill? The motion is to advance LB 635 from General File. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. We take up LB 68.

CLERK: 68 is offered by Senator Landis. (Title read.) Read in January of last year, referred to the Education Committee, advanced to General File. There are committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: Chairman Vickers, committee amendments.

SENATOR VICKERS: Mr. President, LB 68 is a bill to establish the fact that public schools may charge for before and after school services. The committee amendments simply clarifies that. There was one section of the bill that was not quite clear that the committee felt that perhaps the impact of the bill might be such that some people could believe that they could charge for some other of the services as well and so the committee amendments simply would reestablish what the intent of LB 68 was. I ask for the adoption of the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: Is there discussion on the Education Committee amendments to LB 68? If not, the motion is to adopt the amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to adopt the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: The amendments are adopted. Senator Landis.
