introduced to set up a mechanism for the evaluation procedures for administrators. I will explain the amendment if I can find it. The bill as...the amendment provides that the valuation would be semiannual the first two years of employment. The bill, as introduced, would have made it annual rather than semiannual. We changed that to semiannual the first two years and annual thereafter. And also the committee amendment removes the superintendent from the paragraph defining how teacher evaluations are to be conducted thereby allowing the boards to evaluate the superintendent as an administrator rather than putting them in the position of being evaluated as a teacher. I would ask for the adoption of the committee amendments, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Any discussion on the committee amendments? If not, the motion is to adopt the amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Voting on the adoption of the Education Committee amendments to 534. Please record your vote. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the committee amendments, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The amendments are adopted. Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I think that Senator Vickers, in the amendment that he just summarized for you, basically told you what the bill is composed of. There is not much more to it than that other than the fact that it removes superintendents from the same kind of rule as far as being evaluated as classroom instructors are. The pattern seemed inappropriate and so I would just ask for the advancement of the bill based on the committee amendment change and the bill itself.

PRESIDENT: Is there discussion on the bill? If not, the motion is to advance LB 534 from General File. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. You are voting on the advancement of 534. Please record your vote. Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 534 is advanced. LB 642.
