

PRESIDENT: The committee amendments are adopted. Senator Neison, anything further on the bill?

SENATOR NELSON: No, I do not. I just move to move the bill.

So it takes Satellite dishes out of the bill. It leaves it only illegal to pirate transmissions out of a cable. I would ask the adoption of the committee amendment.
