

February 21, 1986 LB 309, 908

I move the adoption of the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: Further discussion on the committee amendments? The motion is to adopt the amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Please record your vote on adoption of the amendments to LB 309, the committee amendments. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: The committee amendments are adopted. Anything further, Senator Schmit?

SENATOR SCHMIT: Nothing further on the bill, Mr. President. I move the bill be advanced.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance the bill. Further discussion? All those in favor of advancing vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. Next is LB 908.

CLERK: Mr. President, 908 was a bill introduced by Senator DeCamp. (Read title.) The bill was read on January 10 of this year, referred to the Banking Committee, advanced to General File. There are committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: Senator Pappas, are you going to handle these for us?

SENATOR PAPPAS: Yes. Mr. President, colleagues, basically, the committee amendments add the E clause to it. This is a bill to allow the Director of Banking the authority to regulate and inspect state chartered credit unions and it came out of committee with no dissenting votes and I ask for the adoption of the committee amendments and advancement of the bill.
