PRESIDENT: Senator Vickers.

SENATOR VICKERS: Mr. President, LB 802 as introduced would have eliminated the sunset provision that is in the statutes on the technical community colleges' ability to levy a property tax. The committee amendment reinstates that sunset provision but puts the date at 1992. I would urge the adoption of the committee amendment.

PRESIDENT: Is there discussion on the committee amendment? If not, the motion is to adopt the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: The committee amendments are adopted. There is a matter...

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Abboud would move to indefinitely postpone the bill. That would lay it over unless the introducer wants to take it up at this time.

PRESIDENT: Senator Vickers, do you wish to take this up? We have a minimum...we have about less than...about eight seconds...eight minutes left for discussion.

SENATOR VICKERS: Well, Mr. President, I guess we would probably run out of time if Senator Abboud is serious about his motion to indefinitely postpone, but I would simply remind Senator Abboud and the members of the body that if you don't have that sunset provision or if you don't extend the sunset provision, then we are going to have to come up with the funds at this level.

PRESIDENT: I take it we are taking it up for discussion.

SENATOR VICKERS: No, I will go ahead and lay it over then if he is serious about his kill motion. Well, let's go ahead and take it.

PRESIDENT: All right.

SENATOR VICKERS: I mean, what the heck, we will just run out of time.
