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school the teacher is in. It doesn't make any difference. The school facility has got to allow that teacher a half an hour uninterrupted lunch period so long as that teacher is not the only person in the facility. That's all it does.

SENATOR PIRSCH: Okay, and, of course, your original bill included a fine then if they did not do that...

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Yes.

SENATOR PIRSCH: ...which was the hammer to do that. And, as I understand it, the committee amendments take out that fine provision.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Yes, I don't think the fine is necessary.

SENATOR PIRSCH: So what do we have left, really?

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: What you have got left is you have got a law that if schoolteachers have to...if they have to enforce it, if they end up having to enforce it, they will do it through the Commission of Industrial Relations.

SENATOR PIRSCH: They cannot do that now?

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: They can't if they don't have the law to allow them to do it. Class Is and Class IIs don't have the law now.

SENATOR PIRSCH: Oh, okay, this is aimed then at Class Is, Class IIs.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Right.

SENATOR PIRSCH: Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Senator Vickers. Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Thank you. Senator Johnson, I would just like a little clarification. You said as long as there is no...as there is another person, did you mean person as such or teacher? Another teacher in the building.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Teacher.
