CLERK: (Commenced reading LB 258 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: I have been reminded by a couple members of the Legislature that we have a rule that says you should be in your seat while we are on Final Reading and we must enforce that rule. So would you please return to your seats and thank you. We are about halfway through this bill so we will be back off it shortly. Thank you.

(Recorder not activated for balance of Final Reading on LB 258.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 258 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. It requires 25 votes. Four are excused this morning. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 972 of the Legislative Journal.) 28 ayes, 16 nays, 4 excused and not voting, 1 present and not voting, Mr. Clerk.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill passes. We will move on to the top of the list now to LB 125. The paper is jammed so we will be a moment here. Reading 494, we will take 494 up in its regular order. All right, Mr. Clerk, 125.

CLERK: (Read LB 125 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Having complied with all the provisions of law, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 972-73 of the Legislative Journal.) 45 ayes, 0 nays, 4 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 125 passes. LB 374.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion on the desk. Senator Wesely would move to return 374 to Select File for specific amendment.
