CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays to advance the A bill,
Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill is advanced. Could I have your attention to introduce a special guest under the south balcony, a sister of Senator Jerry Miller, Jane Kostsioputos of Kearney. Would you please stand, Jane, so that we can see you. Thank you for visiting with us this morning. Move on to LB 438. Do you want to read something in, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, a few items, LR 348 by Senator Morehead. (Read explanation of resolution. See page 992 of the Legislative Journal.) That will be laid over.

Your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports 300 to Select File, 448 to Select File, 504 to Select File, 433 to Select File, those are signed by Senator Hall. (See pages 993-94 of the Legislative Journal.)

Constitutional Revision gives notice of hearing room change; Senator Chronister has amendments to 291 to be printed.

SPEAKER NICHOL: We will move on then to LB 438.

CLERK: Mr. President, 438 is a bill introduced by Senator Withem. (Read title.) It was read on January 21 of last year. It was referred to Health and Human Services, advanced to General File. There are committee amendments.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Wesely, please.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, members, LB 438 was introduced last year, went through 407 review. This is another one of those bills that everybody agreed to. It came in from the dentists. They wanted to restrict and regulate anesthesia provided by dentists and make sure that we have careful oversight in that function. It is interesting that a profession would come in to regulate themselves because they were concerned about a problem. I commend them for that. The technical committee agreed, the Director of Health agreed, and so did the Health and Human Services Committee and so there is agreement on that. The committee amendments clarified the bill in about the utilization of a permit, and so I would ask support for the committee amendments.
