

Health recommended they should not be licensed. The committee did come forward recommending that they should be licensed. These committee amendments would conform that licensure with the uniform licensure law so I would ask your support for the committee amendments to clarify the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Please vote promptly. A little help please. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of committee amendments.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The committee amendments are adopted. Senator Wesely, anything further?

CLERK: Mr. President, I have an amendment from Senator Wesely to the bill. (Wesely amendment appears on pages 995-96 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, this is again a date change. The Health Department after the bill was reported out had to get some dates changed in some of the bills and so this would just do that. It is a technical amendment on the dates in the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, the question is the adoption of the Wesely amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We are voting on the Wesely amendment, a little help please. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Wesely's amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The Wesely amendment is adopted. Anything further on it, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Nothing further, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Wesely, on your bill. Senator Chronister, on your bill. Excuse me. I am sorry.

SENATOR WESELY: It is his bill but I would like to speak against it, if you don't mind, but Harry hasn't had a chance to talk about it so I would rather give him a chance to speak.
