SENATOR CHRONISTER: I don't want Senator Wesely to feel that he has been surprised so I would move that we put it on on Select.

SENATOR HARTNETT: What makes up the board, the six members, the makeup of the board, Senator?

SENATOR CHRONISTER: All right...

SENATOR HARTNETT: It is new to me I guess and I am just asking for clarification is all. You specify some.

SENATOR WESELY: There is no board. They have never been licensed before. There is no existing board.

SENATOR HARTNETT: But who makes up...who will be on this? Who will be the six members, Senator Wesely? Is there...you are talking about a physician and somebody. I just want it for our own information. Who appoints them?

SENATOR WESELY: Since I didn't know about this amendment, Senator Hartnett, I don't know the answer to those questions.
