SENATOR CHRONISTER: Yes, I would just like to close on the bill and ask you to support the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the Chronister amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Senator Chronister.

SENATOR CHRONISTER: At this hour, roll call. We need 25 votes, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Yes, sir.

SENATOR CHRONISTER: A call of the house and a roll call vote.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 6 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The house is under call. Will you please return to your desks and record your presence. Those not in the Legislative Chamber, please return to the Chamber and record your presence. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. So please look up to see if your green light is lit, and if it isn't, please light it. Senator Haberman, your phone is ringing. Senator Chris Abboud, Senator Chambers, Senator Goodrich, Senator Vard Johnson, Senator Labedz, Senator Pirsch, Senator Rogers. Please return, members of the Legislature, so we can move on. Senators, please return to your desks. There are several of you in the Chamber but not at your desk and we can't move on until...did you ask for a roll call vote, Senator Chronister. We are voting on the Chronister amendment. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 997-98 of the Legislative Journal.) 19 ayes, 10 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The motion fails. Do you have anything else on it, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: No, I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.
