wholeheartedly. So Dr. Wright's objections were very weak. The Technical Review Committee, composed of several people, endorsed this idea of 291, and based on that, I ask the passage of the bill from General File to E & R.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Did you consider that your closing, Senator Chronister? All right. The question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Please vote if you care to. Would you folks please stand and be recognized. Thank you, Gregg and Gordon. We are voting on the advancement of the bill, and please those of you who have come in, please record your presence. Call in votes are authorized. Recording your presence please is Senator Labedz, Senator Haberman, Senator Pirsch.

CLERK: Senator Rod Johnson voting no. Senator Lundy voting no. Senator Withem voting yes. Senator Hoagland voting no. Senator Nelson voting no.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, we have had a request for a roll call vote in the regular order. We are looking for Senator Beutler, Senator Beyer, Senator Chambers, Senator Goodrich, Senator Landis, Senator Miller, Senator Morehead, Senator Sieck, and Senator Smith, Senator Schmit, Senator Rogers. Okay, Senator Miller, then Senator Goodrich, and Senator Chambers. We have three guests of Senator Haberman with us this morning. Under the south balcony we have Tanya Benda of Alliance, Sharon Lenz of Hyannis, and Rene Thunker of Elgin, Nebraska. Would you ladies please stand. Thank you for visiting us this morning. Senator Chronister we are still lacking three senators, do you wish to hold up?
