

February 25, 1986 LB 286A

CLERK: Mr. President, 286A is a bill by Senator Morehead. (Read title.) I do have an amendment from Senator Wesely.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Yes, I would just move advancement of the A bill.

CLERK: Senator, you have an amendment. (Wesely amendment appears on page 999 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR WESELY: Oh, I am sorry. Okay, yes, this is just a technical amendment on the A bill on how the Cash Funds would be utilized. These bills are all paid for out of Cash Funds, by the way. The General Fund money is paid out of Cash Fund money so there is no tax impact so this would make that clear.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the Wesely amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Please vote so we can move on. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the Wesely amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The Wesely amendment is adopted. Do you have anything else on it, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Nothing further, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Morehead or Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: I move its advancement.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, the question is the advancement of LB 286A. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance the A bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill is advanced. I would like to get through with these if we could today. Let me introduce a couple of guests of Senator Peterson, Dr. Jim Merritt and Brad Krivohlavek from Norfolk, Nebraska. Would you gentlemen please stand, under the south balcony. Thank you.
