

SPEAKER NICHOL: The Goll amendment is adopted. Now we are back on the committee amendments. Any discussion? The question is the adoption of the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Voting on the committee amendments. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the committee amendments, Mr. President.
