PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Lynch.

SENATOR LYNCH: Mr. President and members, actually the bill, a major part of the cost is \$2,000 for the developing the different colored backdrops for the picture and that's about it. Everything else will stay the same. The bill did provide though for a fee increase from two to five dollars. That will develop some general revenue funds for the state and also for the counties. I'd like to quickly add, too, that I would like to think that the cost is not actually what it is prescribed to be in issuing these licenses. That cost does not include the cost for providing the space, the staff or anything else. It's just a paperwork cost. We estimate that there will be about 25,000 people who are regularly and have traditionally asked for duplicate licenses. We estimate also that about 75 percent of those kids who turn 21 and who have not had the four years expiration date completed on their license might apply for a duplicate license so that they can be...so it can be shown that they are in fact, legally of age and I would ask for your...and the fiscal note is attached I think to the bill.
