PRESIDENT: Is there discussion on 774A? If not, the motion is to advance the bill from General File. Senator Haberman.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Senator Hefner, Mr. President, members of the body, or, Senator Hefner, will you yield to a question?

SENATOR HEFNER: Certainly.

SENATOR HABERMAN: I notice that this I believe carried a price tag of 55,000. Is that correct?

SENATOR HEFNER: Yes, that's what I said. For the next fiscal year \$55,000 and this would be used for a new system. We'd have to have...this would be used for the data processing and then the next fiscal year it would drop to \$18,300.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Is there any way we could recover this from the income that we're generating?

SENATOR HEFNER: Well, Senator Haberman...

SENATOR HABERMAN: In other words, the tax is going to go up to approximately \$4 million and can't that tax then be returned to offset this expenditure?

SENATOR HEFNER: We figure this will raise between 3 and \$4 million and of this 2 million would be new money, so I would think that we could certainly take \$55,000 out of the \$2 million of new money.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Okay, Senator Hefner. Thank you very, very much.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on LB 774A? If not, the motion is to advance the bill from General File. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. The motion is to advance LB 774A from General File. Please record your vote. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. LB 795A.
