CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the A bill.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The bill is advanced.  
LB 1051A.

CLERK: 1051A is offered by Senators Chizek and Wesely.  
(Title read.)

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Chizek.

SENATOR CHIZEK: Mr. President and members, LB 1051 is the A bill that would initiate the start-up costs for the certification in licensing of those who are involved with the asbestos removal, et cetera. The expenditure of \$34,700 and revenues of 37,500 and I would ask your advancement of the bill.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on LB 1051A? If not, the motion is to advance the bill from General File. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? The motion is to advance the bill from General File. Please record your vote. Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance the A bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The A bill is advanced. We move on to the special order this morning. The first one is the discussion of LB 243.

CLERK: Mr. President, if I might right before we proceed to that...

PRESIDENT: Matter for the record?

CLERK: Yes, sir. Mr. President, I have just one item and that is that Public Works gives notice of confirmation hearing, signed by Senator Schmit as Chair. Mr. President, LB 243 was a bill that was introduced by Senators Pappas, Higgins, Schmit and Hannibal. (Title read.) It was read in January of last year, referred to the Health and Human Services Committee for hearing, was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending.
