SENATOR WESELY: No, I'd just appreciate adoption of the committee amendments. They also conform the bill to the Uniform Licensure Act as well as going from licensure of nutritionists and dietitians to only the licensure of dietitians.

PRESIDENT: The motion is the adoption of the committee amendments to the LB 243. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Voting on the adoption of committee amendments to LB 243. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of committee amendments, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The committee amendments are adopted.
