

CLERK: Mr. President, 839 was a bill introduced by the Speaker at the request of the Governor. (Title read.) The bill was read on January 9 of this year. It was referred to the Appropriations Committee for public hearing. The bill was advanced to General File, Mr. President. There are Appropriations Committee amendments pending.

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner, do you wish to explain the Appropriations Committee amendments? Do you want Senator Haberman to go first?

SENATOR WARNER: I don't know, I thought he wanted the Chair's attention.

PRESIDENT: Well, he did, but he wants to divide a question, but I thought I'd have you explain the amendments first.

SENATOR WARNER: Oh, okay. Well, Mr. President, in that case let me say that as we have always done where there are numerous amendments or numerous sections to a bill, any particular item that any individual member would like to have pulled out to vote separately, they obviously are divisible and there is no...I certainly would agree with that procedurally so what I'd like to do, on the sheets that you have, passed out this morning, I would like to touch on only those items first that are in the committee amendment and the sheets you have include both the committee amendment as well as the bill as introduced by the Governor. So if you would make notations, I will tell you which ones are in the committee amendment. On page 1 the items dealing with the Legislative Council is in the committee amendment. The \$64,592 Cash Fund is to set up the necessary fund that handles that legislative shared information system with I assume many of you are familiar with which is the computer arrangement where local governmental subdivisions or others can, by paying for it, secure some of that information such as bill status and that information that is available to whoever wishes to pay for it. And the second portion deals with some transfer of funds within programs in order to provide some revenue for the Special Committee on Economic Development. The next one, 05, the Supreme Court is...all of those items there is some, no new money. It's reducing appropriations in two programs and adding to another program within the court, but there is no additional money, but it obviously takes an amendment to appropriation to move money to those other programs.
