SENATOR WARNER: If the Clerk would, or if Senator Nichol would indicate to the Clerk that he would like to have that section dealing with Section 10 of the bill in the item dealing with program 108 to be voted separately, I'll withdraw that one from the...

PRESIDENT: You asked for a division of that, Senator?

SPEAKER NICHOL: Yes, Mr. President, on that particular portion and, Mr. Clerk, do I need to bring up a...? Okay.

PRESIDENT: Very well, we will divide out then a consideration of Section 10 for the second division of the question. Any further divisions of questions requested? Senator Haberman, do you have a problem?

SENATOR HABERMAN: (Response inaudible.)

PRESIDENT: Let the Chair review now what we have done on divisions. On the first page under 03, Legislative Council, we have excluded all Legislative Council items 122 through 127 in a separate question and we've excluded on page 4, item 17 of Section 10, Department of Revenue, 102, 108 as a separate question. So far we have all the other body of the amendments as a...one group. Senator Haberman, do you have a point?

SENATOR HABERMAN: We're going to debate it separately or we aren't?

PRESIDENT: We are. What you have asked, Senator, is divided out as a separate question. And then we also divided out the Section 10 which is on page 4 on 16, Department of Revenue. Those are the only divisions thus far.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Fine, I have no questions on that.

PRESIDENT: Very well. Any further divisions of question? All right then we will take up first the body of the amendments that are not divided out, that is almost all except Section 10 and Section 5. Is there discussion on those measures? Anything further, Senator Warner?
