PRESIDENT: Senator Lundy, do you want to speak on the Morehead amendment?

SENATOR LUNDY: Mr. President, members of the body, I, too, agree with this amendment. I think it is technical in nature and I would urge your passage on this amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hoagland. The question has been called. Do I see five seconding hands? I do. The question is, shall the debate cease on the Morehead amendment? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. The motion is to cease debate on the Morehead amendment. Twenty-five votes required. If you wish to vote, please record your vote. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate.

PRESIDENT: The motion carried. Senator Morehead, you may close.

SENATOR MOREHEAD: Mr. President and members of the body, I apologize for not bringing it before the Revenue Committee but it wasn't brought to me until after the hearing. I appreciate Senator Sieck and Senator Lundy addressing this and so I would ask for the adoption of this technical amendment.

PRESIDENT: The motion is the adoption of the Morehead amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Morehead's amendment.

PRESIDENT: The Morehead amendment is adopted. Next on the desk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Pappas would move to amend by adding the emergency clause.

PRESIDENT: Senator Pappas withdraws his amendment.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill.

PRESIDENT: All right. Senator Sieck, I guess we are back
