want to exercise that responsibility I think they can do it well, but I agree with Senator Scofield that there needs to be some emphasis placed upon that funding responsibility so that it does not, in effect, go by the wayside. I want to say now that we advance the bill. I'd be glad to sit down with Senator Scofield and anyone else and take a good look at the bill prior to its action on Select File. I hope the bill does advance today. I would urge you to read the committee's statement and recognize the broad support the bill has, recognize that it is an all encompassing bill, but recognize also that its limitations are in its funding and the willingness of the people of the State of Nebraska and the individuals involved who carry out intent of the bill. I ask that the bill be advanced.

SENATOR MARSH: We are now ready and will vote on the advancement of LB 894. Opposed vote no...all those in favor vote aye, opposed no. The Clerk will record. We will quickly take the A bill before we leave.
