SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President and members of the body, this is a hard act to follow but I will do my best. The Miscellaneous Subjects Committee met the other day and we had three Governor appointments to consider. The first one was Ted Kooser from Lincoln and Robert Ripley from Lincoln. The appointment was to the Arts Council. The other one was Robert Sim, our neighbor to the north here. He lives in Lincoln and he works at the Woodmen Life and his appointment was to the Accountability and Disclosure Commission. So at this time I move that we adopt the appointments of the Governor to these various positions.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the...the confirmation of the report. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays on approval of the confirmation report, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The report is confirmed. We will move on to number 7, Select File.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first order of business is LB 839 and I have E & R amendments on 839, Senator.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Hall, please.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I would move the E & R amendments be adopted.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You have heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have nothing further on the bill.

All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced. We will move on to Select File.
