

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I would move the E & R amendments be adopted.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You have heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, I now have a series of amendments. The first amendment I have to the bill is by Senator...the first amendment I have to the bill is by Senator Warner. Senator Warner's amendment is on page 801 of the Journal.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Warner, please.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. Clerk, is that amendment 2072?

CLERK: Yes, sir.
