CLERK: 15 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The house is under call. Will you please record your presence, those that are here. Those that are not here, please return to the Chambers and record your presence. There are several of you here who have not recorded your presence, like Senator Schmit, Senator Warner, Senator Rupp, Senator Harris, Senator Morehead. We are looking for Senator DeCamp, Senator Goodrich, Senator Baack, Senator Higgins, Senator Rogers, Senator Rupp. Please record your presence. Senator Warner. Thank you. We are looking for Senator Wesely, Senator Rupp. Looking for Senator DeCamp, Senator Carson Rogers. Looking for Senator DeCamp and Senator Wesely. Senator DeCamp is on his way, I understand, Senator Hefner, so that will be it.
