SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the Warner-Hoagland amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Warner and Hoagland's amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have is by Senators Hoagland, Lamb and Scofield. It is found on page 903 of the Journal.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All right, Senator Hoagland, are you going to handle that first?

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Briefly, Mr. Speaker, this amendment is printed on page 903 of the Journal. I am also asking a Page to hand it out right now. It does two things. At the request of Senator Lamb and Senator Scofield and others from that part of the state, it strikes one sentence from LB 529. The second thing it does is it changes the effective date to July 1, 1986, for certain portions of the bill. It is highly technical. I would ask your adoption. Thank you.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any further discussion on the amendment? All those in favor of the amendment vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The amendment is adopted. Anything further, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have is by Senator Hoagland. Senator, this is amendment number 2222. It is also printed separately. You will find it in your bill books.
