Now this is all highly technical material dealing with clerk magistrates, dealing with venue provisions, dealing with...now dealing with reorganizing the probation system and sunsetting the current probation law. It really is noncontroversial. It is going to make the system work better. The temporary restraining order amendment that I offered was also noncontroversial but I withdrew that out of courtesy to Senator Schmit. It does not deserve any more of this Legislature's time. Finally, once it is advanced to Final Reading, there will, of course, be a new copy printed that will be a combination of these two things I am holding up, basically. So I would ask that we not hold the bill up, that we advance it to Final Reading and get on with the other business this morning. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Marsh, please, and then...

SENATOR MARSH: I move the previous question.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, the question has been called. Do I see five hands? I do. The question is, shall debate cease? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We are voting to cease debate. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.
