that. So I'd support this amendment although I think even the amendment is a little bit high.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Vard, did you wish to speak?

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Yes, Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, the amendment is a reasonable amendment that will make a bill that a lot of us have thought excessive far more acceptable and I know that the bill's sponsors have essentially come to that understanding. The bill's sponsors keep asking me how I'm going to vote on this bill when the bill finally goes and I will answer them very carefully that at this juncture with this amendment on it there is no reason for me not to support this measure nor is there any reason for other senators not to support this measure. Of course, reasons can surface, but I know of none offhand. With that, I would ask your favorable consideration of the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the Vard Johnson amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 7 nays on the motion to adopt the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, we're on the advancement of the bill now. Senator Vard Johnson moves its advancement. Senator Schmit, your light is on. Did you wish to speak or are you in the Chamber? We're on the advancement of the bill. Okay. The question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted that care to? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 7 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill is advanced. Do you have anything to put into the record, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes, sir. Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports LB 1246, LB 675, LB 1051,
