SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, I would like you to just vote to strike Section 3. That is my number fourth item.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All right, is that what we are voting on right now?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: That is what I would like to substitute, yes.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Is that up here? Do you have that...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, it is in the Journal.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I'm dropping the number two item that I offered and I am dropping my number three amendment that I offered and I am asking you to adopt my number four amendment which is to strike Section 3 of the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Is there discussion on that? The question is the adoption of the Chambers amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of that amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The amendment is adopted. Do you have anything you wish to read in at this time, Mr. Clerk? The call is raised.

CLERK: No, sir, I do not.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All right, we will move on then to Select File, nonpriority bills, number seven that you will notice at the bottom of your first page, and we have quite a few of them that we will be taking up and moving that do not have amendments. So, Senator Hall, are you ready?

SENATOR HALL: Please?
