LB 992A, 1114

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, this is a bill that came out of the Executive Committee that transfers to the Secretary of State the functions that are now performed by the Revisor of Regulations. This is a \$28,000 A bill that follows with that responsibility. And I would move for the advancement of the A bill. Thank you.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the advancement of the A bill. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance LB 992A.

SPEAKER NICHOL: It is advanced. Move on to LB 1114 under special order, number six.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 1114 is on Select File. The first item I have are E & R amendments, Senator Hall.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Hall, please.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I'd move the E & R amendments be adopted.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You've heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Vard Johnson would move to amend. (V. Johnson amendment is found on pages 1215-19 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Vard Johnson.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, and Mr. Clerk, is there not an amendment to this amendment that I am moving to amend?

CLERK: Yes, sir, there is.
