LB 993, 994

SENATOR HIGGINS: Thank you, Mr. President. Question of Senator Carsten. As I read the agenda it says, repeal the Unicameral Research Institute and Legislative Council Executive Director. We're going to get rid of the Executive Director?

SENATOR CARSTEN: As I understand correctly this has been done, but the statute has never been changed.

SENATOR HIGGINS: Okay, thank you, Senator.

SENATOR CARSTEN: It was done sometime back, in '74, I think, or somewhere in that area.

SENATOR HIGGINS: Thank you.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Please vote. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance 993, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill advances. LB 994.

CLERK: LB 994 was introduced by Senator Beutler. (Read title.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Carsten.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, here again is a proposal that repeals something that has not been in use for the last ten years. It does direct the Revisor of Statutes to publish judicial annotations in the form of pocket parts to the statutes. It would delete this requirement so as to conform to the section, to repeal...or reflect the current practice. As I said, it has not been used for 10 years, and certainly is an obsolete part of the statutes. I would move for its advancement, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Please vote. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.
