

explain this adequately. We now do not have control over our space. The Department of Administrative Services has control over our space. So we are trying to bring the statutes into compliance with what we have informally been doing through the years. The statutes say that we shall have a five-year plan for the entire Capitol. That was done before 1976. This is obsolete language. This is not an attempt to take over the Governor's section. It is an attempt to have the Legislature have control over the space which the Legislature uses in the State Capitol. I move for its advancement.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Okay, that was the closing. All those in favor of advancing LB 1227 will vote aye, those opposed will vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 9 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The bill is advanced. Thank you, Senator Marsh. Before we move to the next bill, I did not have this before me when I introduced the other Kiwanis members, but in addition to those, there are also 50 Kiwanis members that are watching our Legislature this morning, and to all of you we say welcome. We would like for you to stand that we may recognize all of you. Thank you for coming. LB 1160, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: LB 1160 by Senator Lynch. (Read title.) First read on January 22 of this year, referred to the Judiciary, advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Senator Lynch.

SENATOR LYNCH: Mr. President and members, this could be considered a technical revisor's bill simply put. The Federal Controlled Substances Act is designed to regulate the manufacturing, distribution, and dispensing of narcotics and dangerous drugs. Controlled Substances Act separates the drugs into five classes based upon their abuse potential. These separate classifications are called "schedules". The five schedules of controlled substances range from Schedule I drugs which have the most abuse potential and which have no acceptable use, such as, LSD and heroin, to Schedule V which is least addictive and is like cough syrup containing codeine.
