I think that these reserve deputy sheriffs should come under the blanket bond and I just question it from the standpoint of whether or not when the bill passes the various counties that have the blanket bond might receive an increase in bonding premiums. That is all I am saying, and between now and Final Reading, you might want to check it out or the counties might, but I am going to vote for the bill. Thank you.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The question is the adoption of the committee amendments. Do you have any closing, Senator Hoagland? The question is then the adoption of the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of committee amendments.
