

SENATOR PIRSCH: Okay, thank you. I have other questions on the bill but I will wait.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The question then is the amendment to the committee amendment. All those in favor will vote aye, those opposed will vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 18 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the amendment to the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Senator Lynch, are you going to take the committee amendments as amended now.

SENATOR LYNCH: Yes, Mr. President, I think the amendments including the amendment to the committee amendment has already been adequately described. I would move for the adoption of the committee amendments.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Okay, the question is the adoption of the committee amendments as amended. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of committee amendments.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Senator Lynch, do you want to say anything more in your introduction now of the bill as a whole as amended?
