LB 799, 1027, 1027A

SENATOR CARSTEN: Senator Rod Johnson, please.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Are we on the bill?

SENATOR CARSTEN: On the bill as amended, Senator Johnson.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: I just want to go on record as saying that I will sponsor an amendment that would amend or change the sales tax on occasional farm sales on Select File. I recognize that we are limited on time and I won't badger the bill here but I did want that on the record and I believe the amendment has been filed with the Clerk.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Okay, all those in favor of advancing LB 1027 as amended will vote aye, those opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The bill is advanced as amended. The next bill, 1027A, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, 1027A is a bill by Senator Vard Johnson. (Read title.)

SENATOR CARSTEN: Senator Johnson, on 1027A.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: This is a very small A bill that goes along with 1027. It will, obviously, get amended on Select File because I know that a lot of other amendments are going to come to 1027. This will be the Revenue Committee's Christmas tree bill. The A bill though at this juncture is insignificant in nature.

SENATOR CARSTEN: All those in favor of advancing LB 1027A will vote aye, those opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the A bill.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The bill is advanced. The next bill is LB 799. Is that correct, Mr. Clerk?
