

SENATOR VICKERS: No. To the bill.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Okay, let's adopt the committee amendments then first. All those in favor of adopting the committee amendments as was amended by Senator Rogers vote aye, those opposed vote no. We have three minutes left on this bill so we need to move fairly rapidly if we are going to take care of it. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the committee amendments.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The committee amendments are adopted. Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DECAMP: I will tell you what, I am going to offer the E clause. If we are going to do this, let's get it done in time for the planting season.

SENATOR CARSTEN: All right, the amendment is to add the emergency clause. Is there anyone that wishes to speak on it? If not, all those in favor of adopting the emergency clause to the committee amendments vote aye, those opposed no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of that amendment.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The E clause is adopted. Senator Rogers, we have got a little over a minute left.

SENATOR ROGERS: How many lights do we have on?

SENATOR CARSTEN: One.

SENATOR ROGERS: Tom. Let Senator Vickers go ahead.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Senator Vickers.

SENATOR ROGERS: Maybe he will close.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Senator Vickers, please.
